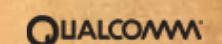

## Mozart ♥ Prague

**Guest artist: Ines Irawati, piano**

**“This is one of the happiest days of my life,” Mozart said** after the premiere of his now-famous Symphony in D major (the *Prague* Symphony) in Prague. The citizens of this beautiful, sophisticated and appreciative city of the arts loved Mozart and understood his genius. Mozart returned that love with the premiere of two beautiful compositions for “my Praguers.”

*La Clemenza di Tito*, a two-act opera commissioned for the coronation celebrations of King Leopold II of Bohemia, premiered in Prague during the last year of Mozart’s life – **this beautiful overture is pure Mozart!**

Mozart wrote over 30 piano concertos and performed many of them himself. Ines Irawati, one of the most imaginative, artistic young pianists on the music scene today, joins the orchestra to perform his beautiful Piano Concerto No. 20.

## Bach, Baroque and All that Jazz

Bravo to Duke Ellington and Wynton Marsalis, but it's J.S. (Bach, that is) who is really the king of Baroque and All that Jazz! **Baroque musicians were the jazz musicians of their day.**

**It's all about improvisation**, isn't it?!

Improvisation during the Baroque era was all about showing off a musician's virtuosity; improvisation in jazz is all about expressing a musician's mood or feelings.

They may not sound alike but, **technically, jazz and Baroque music are very closely related.** This concert will take you on an absolutely fascinating journey through these two genres of music.
